Q. Are there specific colors of garbage bags that must be used?
 A. No.

Q. Can I put all burnable garbage together into one garbage bag?
 A. You can put them together as long as they are categorized as burnable garbage (e.g., food waste, plastic products without the recycling label).

Q. Are there any changes to the arrangements of garbage collection sites due to the increase in the number of types of garbage?
 A. If you have regular garbage and large-sized garbage collection sites separately, new arrangements of the collection sites are as follows.

Regular garbage collection site	Burnable garbage, plastic containers and packaging, plastic bottles
Large-sized garbage collection site	Garbage other than the ones mentioned above.

Q. How can I dispose of plastic bottles, plastic containers and packaging?
 A. Please put plastic bottles in a bag separately from plastic containers and packaging. Place the bags at the garbage collection sites. A garbage collection vehicle will come and collect plastic bottles first, then another vehicle will come and collect plastic containers and packaging.

Q. Will the collection times change?
 A. The collection times in some areas may change due to changes in schedule.

Q. Will garbage that has been put out on incorrect collection days be collected?
 A. We will put stickers on the garbage explaining the reasons why we could not collect them.

Garbage from business

It is your responsibility to dispose of garbage from your business (e.g., shops, restaurants, hospitals, factories, company offices, etc), regardless of the amount of garbage. You cannot dispose business garbage in residential garbage collection sites.

Disposal methods

- Ask the disposers approved by the city council for collection (Charges apply)

- Bring garbage into Kunisaki Clean Center directly (Charges apply, bookings essential)

Deceased domestic pets (dogs, cats, etc)
 [Charges apply, bookings essential]

Please place them in an appropriate size coffin (e.g., cardboard boxes, etc). No large boxes accepted.

- Please contact the city council to make a booking in the morning, between Monday and Friday. Collections will be made in the afternoon.
- You can also bring them directly to the Kawanishi City Crematory (Phone: 799-0331)

The City Council will not collect TVs, refrigerators, washing machines, driers, air conditioners, or PCs.

Special disposal methods for these electrical appliances: (i.e., TVs, refrigerators, washing machines, driers, air conditioners)
 Ask the stores where you purchase, or from which you intend to purchase, about their collection terms. You may be charged a recycling and collection fee.
 If you are unsure which store you have purchased them from, or if you have moved and the store is too far away, please contact the Department of Environment on 759-8011.

Disposal methods of household PCs
 ○Contact the manufacturers directly for collection
 You can bring them to a post office* or request for a pickup after making a payment for the recycling fee.
 *Excluding postal agencies
 ○For home-built PCs and PCs of which manufactures are no longer in operation, contact the manufacturers directly or contact PC3R Promotion Center <http://www.pc3r.jp/> on 03-5282-7685.
